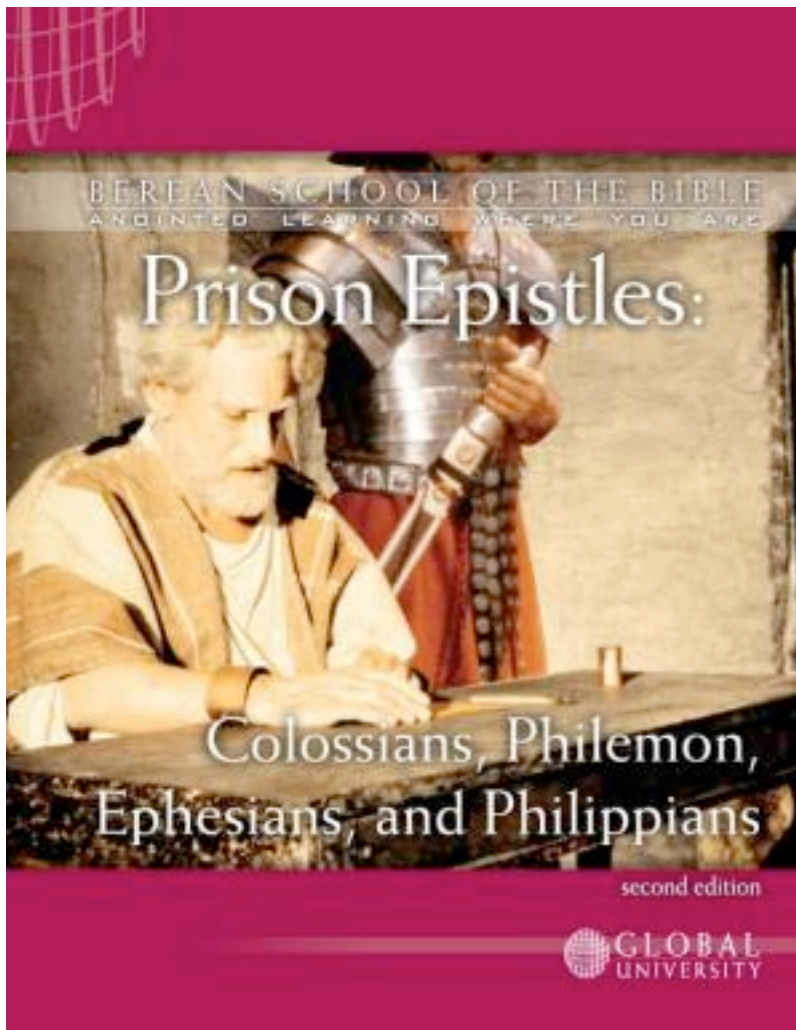

Prison Epistles: Colossians, Philemon, Ephesians, & Philippians

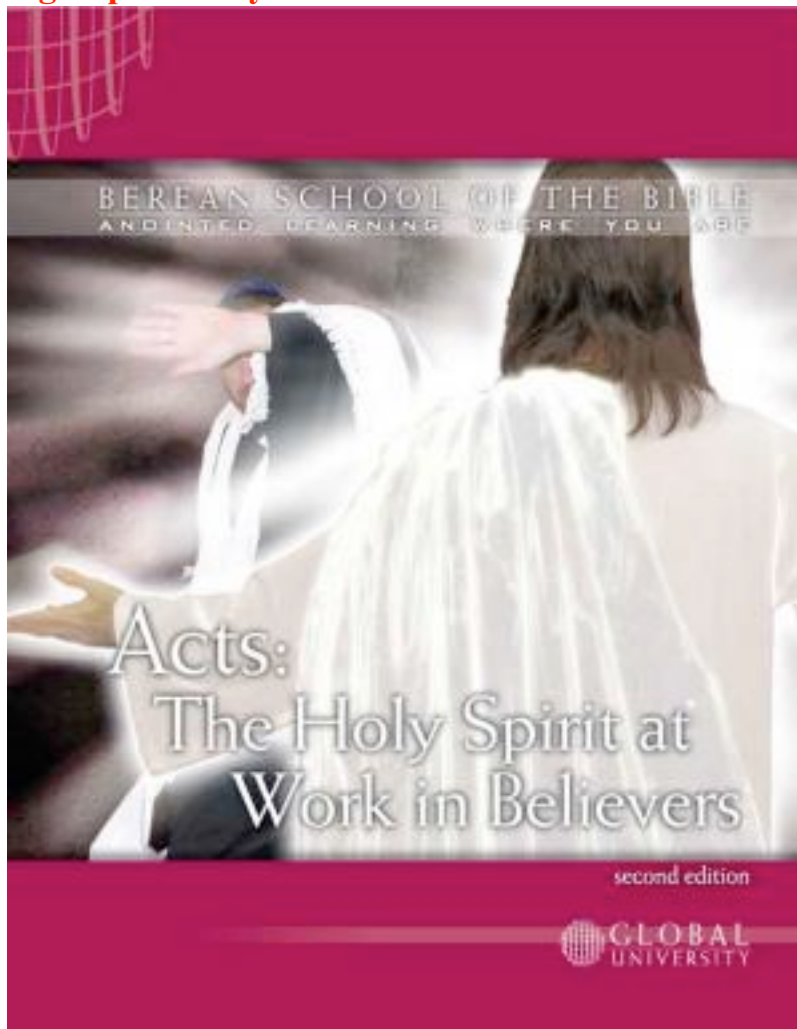
